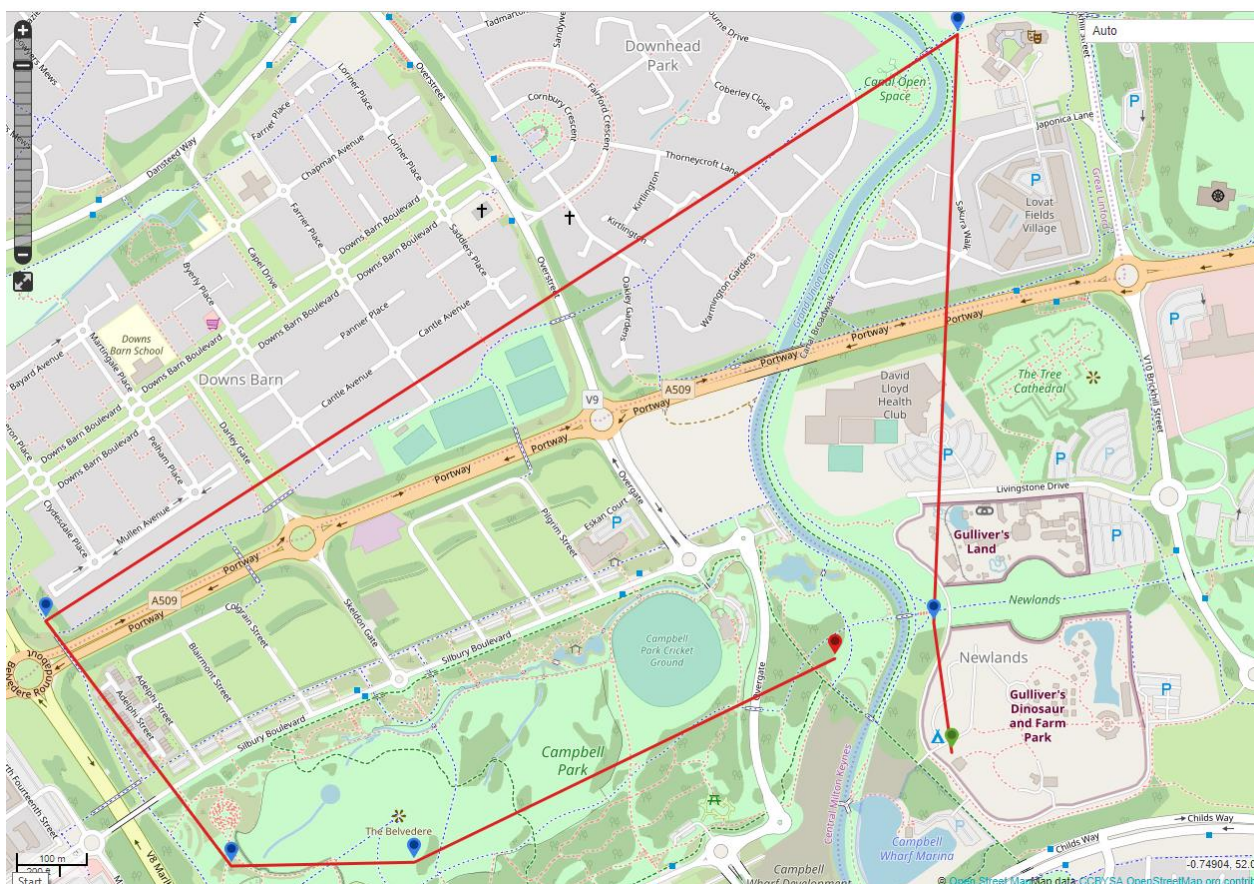


15a Newlands: Campbell and Willen Parks

4.1 miles

Despite the whole walk being within the city area, unless you opt to visit Central Milton Keynes with its unique layout and shopping experience your only contact with roads will be to cross a couple of very quiet, narrow ones. The paths are such that the walk can be undertaken at any time of year and yet you will have some astounding views in the section through Campbell Park. The walk also follows a stretch of the Grand Union Canal.



From the end of the road outside the Gulliver's Camping and Caravanning Club site, take the tarmac track beyond the bollards. At a crossing track turn left towards steps, but bear right at the foot of the steps, then go right again to keep the canal on your left (signposted 'Great Linford, Cosgrove').

Stay on the tarmac track, between poplars, with the canal to your left. Pass beneath a road and continue as before until you reach a crossing track. A few yards to your right are the Camphill Tea Rooms and Community, but you turn left over the canal on a brick bridge (signposted for Downhead Park, Downs Barn).

15b Willen Lake

No written route provided, as clearly signposted by the Trust. Each lap of the Lake is 2.5 miles
