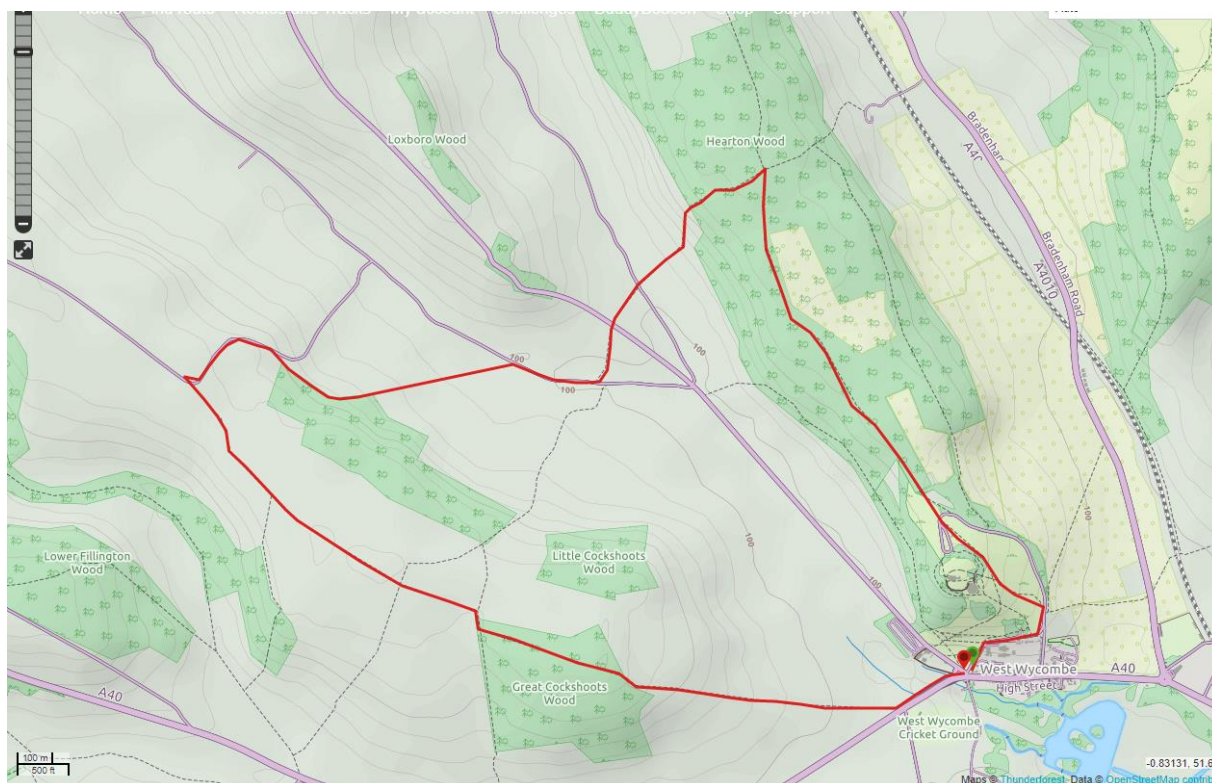


25. West Wycombe 'No Through Road' Walk

Walk past the Hell Fire Caves, up the hill to mausoleum. Built in 1765 on the site of an Iron Age Hill Fort, it houses urns containing the ashes of the Dashwood family.

Take the ridge path in Hearnton Wood from behind St Laurence church. Later, turn left off the main track, following the waymarks to the edge of the wood.

Keep on this path between fields, and cross a lane (Slough Lane) and another field. Cross a stile, then the Chinnor Road, then another stile, with public footpath stick signs.

Gentle descent to Bottom Lane where you turn right to pass a farm, then left at a footpath sign. This path crosses two fields on the diagonal, skirts a copse and finally joins a country lane which bends round to the left.

On the cusp of the bend, turn hard left onto a road leading to a brick farmhouse. You pass this and keep to the track, later a path, across one large field and a smaller one, to reach a small area of woodland. Turn right then soon left to enter the wood.

Once out of the woods follow this path for your final descent to the village, across fields.
