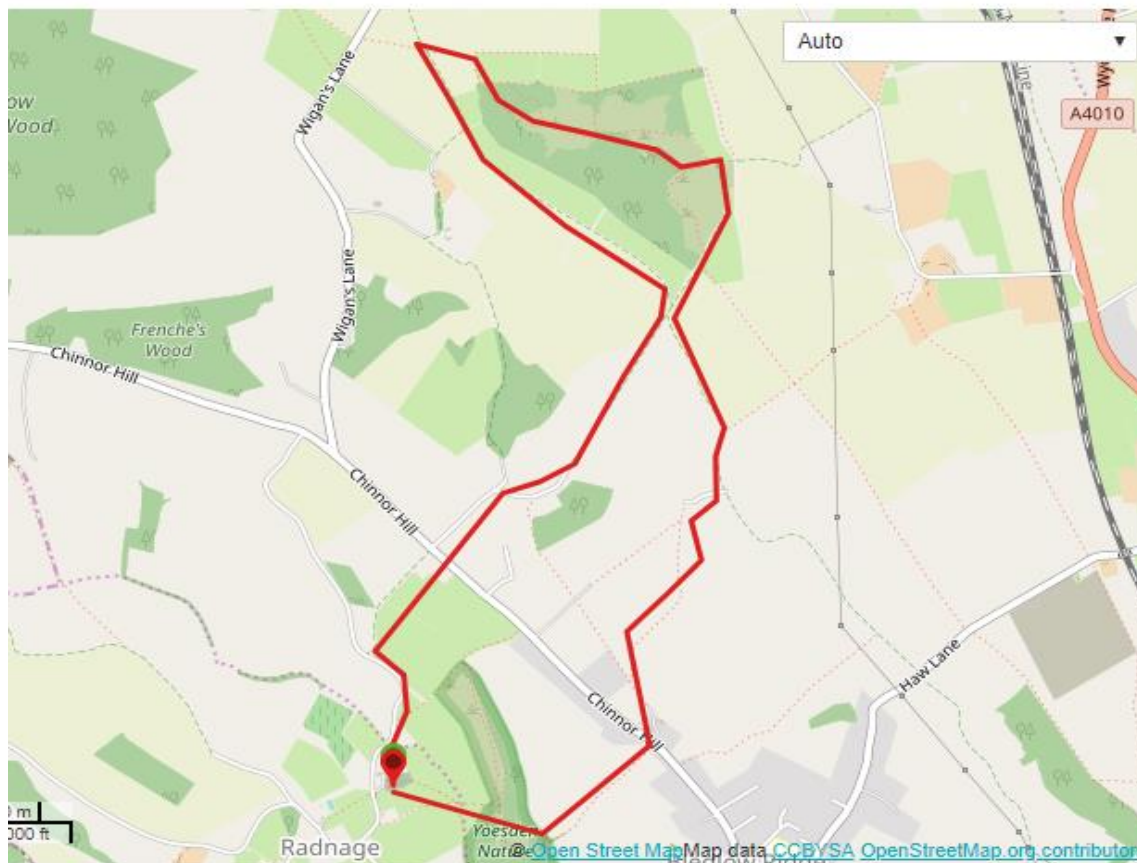


7. Daws Hill Radnage (CAWC)

From St Mary's church, follow Church Lane, later Radnage Lane, north until you see a wooden footpath sign to your right. Take this path across to where it emerges onto Chinnor Road, by a bus stop.

Cross the road and take Routs Green, keeping right at the fork and take the track at the end of this road. Later, at the pointed end of a field, take a left, heading North West along hedgerows, then through a field. At a junction of paths turn right. You should be heading East South East at this point. Turn right again and pass through trees to the viewpoint at Lodge Hill.

As you emerge into the open take another right, to return towards Routs Green. Just after you reach the field with a pointed end point where you turned off previously, turn left across fields.

Passing stables on your right, turn up the second of the drives, looking for a track that leads off almost due South: avoid the path that crosses the field diagonally.

Where this path bends off slightly to the left, take a right hand path, crossing a field and linking up with Boot Lane, off Chinnor Hill. Cross this road and follow footpath signs through Yoesden Nature Reserve and back to the village.
